

STARBOOK INSTRUCTIONS

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INSIDE PAGES

Supplies:

7 sheets 12 x 12 patterned paper (double-sided is best)

Instructions:

Cut each sheet of patterned paper into three strips:

- 1 – 4" x 12"
- 1 – 4" x 10"
- 1 – 4" x 8"

Fold each strip in half, 4" side to 4" side.

Make a stack of paper for each star point, using different patterns for each section. Each star point is made of three layers of paper, one 12" length on the bottom, one 10" length in the center and one 8" length on top.

Use sticky strip (or other similar strong, red-backed tape) to tape the 4" ends of each layer together. Do the left side of each point first, first taping the 12" and 10" lengths together, then adding the 8" length on top. Repeat the process on the right side. You will have seven separate points when you are done.

Using sticky strip, tape the ends of one completed star point to the ends of the next completed star point. Continue until all seven star points are attached in a stack.

COVERS

Supplies:

- 2 – 4-1/8" x 6-1/8" heavy weight card stock or chipboard
- 2 – 5-1/8" x 7-1/8" patterned paper

Instructions:

Adhere one piece of cardboard to the center of one piece of patterned paper, on the wrong side. Glue and wrap the excess paper to the inside to give your cover clean, paper-covered edges. Repeat with the other cover.

Cut a length of ribbon long enough to wrap around your book, plus tie a bow. Wrap the ribbon around the closed book and tie the ribbon to hold it centered and in place while you tape the covers in place. Use sticky strip to attach the front and back covers.

Decorate the front cover. To display the book, open it and tie the cover ribbons together.
